

1004 KULM HIGH SCHOOL DISCIPLINE POLICY

Examples of disciplinary infractions: Others not listed will be referred to the appropriate level offense by the administration.

1004.1 Offenses and Consequences

(Reference North Dakota Century School Code, 15.1-19-09.)

1004.1a Level one Offenses

Disruption of classroom process
Boisterous conduct (running, yelling)
Failure to turn in admit slip on time

1004.1a2 Consequences

1st offenses - warning
2nd offense-detention
Repeated offenses and/or combination of offenses - Saturday detention or out of school suspension 1-10 days.

1004.1b Level II Offenses

Careless driving (includes any street adjacent to the elementary or high school.)
Leaving school grounds without permission
Extreme cases of disrespect
Misuse of school computers, including laptops

1004.1b2 Consequences

1st offense - Saturday detention or out of school suspension 1- (10) days
Repeated offenses - Saturday detention or out of school suspension 1- 10 days, and / or referral to legal authorities for
Disturbance of a public school (misdemeanor offense.)

1004.1c Level III Offenses

Physical attack	Unlawful drugs
Vandalism	Alcohol
Theft	Tobacco
Harassment	Unlawful behavior

1004.1c2 Consequences

1st offense - Saturday detention or out of school suspension 1 - 10 days.
Repeated offense - out of school suspension 1 - 10 days.
Unlawful drugs, alcohol and tobacco on any school property - out of school suspension.
Threatening or intimidating acts - Recommendation for expulsion.

1004.2 Level IV Offenses

Possession or using weapons

1004.2a Consequences

The teacher / staff must notify the Principal of infractions, in writing, on the day in which they occur. The disciplinary referral form will be used. Both the teacher and the parent will receive a copy of the form once the Principal has completed it.

If a student receives Saturday detention or is suspended, they must appear before the re-admittance committee before returning to class. The committee will consist of the student's classroom teacher and the Principal. Parents are required to attend suspension re-admittance meetings before the student is allowed back to school.

1004.2a1 Out of school suspension

Suspensions will follow the guidelines in student handbook page 2-4.

Make up work will follow student handbook guidelines page 8.

Out of school suspension will prohibit a student from attending or participating in any school event on the day of suspension, or through the duration of a suspension.

1004.2a2 Reinstatement after suspension

First suspension - prior to being reinstated in school after having been suspended for the first time, students will be required to sign a re-admittance affidavit. The re-admittance affidavit will include statements indicating that the student knows, understands, and promises to obey the rules of school. Re-admittance hearings are required after every suspension.

Second suspension - Parents must again meet with the re-admittance committee and the student will be placed on a behavior contract. According to the terms of this contract, students will lose 1 point for level 1 infractions, 2 points for level II infractions, and 3 points for Level III infractions. If students are placed on the behavior contract they will receive 3 points at the onset of the contract, and will be awarded 1 point for each month in which they have not committed an infraction during the school year. Any student not losing behavior points for any 6-month consecutive school months will be removed from the behavior contract.

1004.3 EXPULSION

When the number of points in a student behavior contract has been reduced to zero, arrangements for an expulsion hearing before the hearing officer will be made immediately. Whenever an infraction is of such a severe nature that it disrupts the operation of the school, the student responsible will be suspended immediately and expulsion proceedings will be scheduled as soon as possible.
